General Information

Summer School is open to all Grand Haven High School students needing to make-up academic credit. Students from other districts are welcome.

Summer School will be held at **Grand Haven High School**.

Classes will run for 6 weeks, two hours a day, **Wednesday, June 17 through Friday, July 31, 2009**. There will be no school **July 3 and 6, 2009**.

Class hours are: **Session 1, 7:50 a.m.-9:50 a.m. and Session 2, 10:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.**

Attendance Policy: Students are expected to **attend all classes. Only one absence is allowed. Three tardies shall equal one absence. Students having more than one absence will not receive credit in their class. Extenuating circumstances such as accident or illness should be brought to the attention of Mr. Klemm, Summer School Coordinator.**

Students may enroll for a **maximum of two classes**.

Registration Fee is \$130.00 per class for all students. The Registration Fee is non-refundable after June 17, 2009. The Registration Fee must accompany the application. (Exceptions may be granted for students qualifying for financial assistance.)

Students on Free and Reduced Lunch or who meet MICHIGAN WORKS! income guidelines, may qualify for financial assistance. Please inquire when registering.

Students are responsible for their **own transportation** to and from Grand Haven High School.

Classes may be cancelled due to insufficient enrollment.

Course Offerings

9th Grade English	Writing, literature including short stories, mythology, poetry, non fiction, outlining, organization, grammar and vocabulary development	.5 credit BEL
10th Grade American Literature & Comp.	Reading and literature interpretation, summary writing, expository essays, vocabulary building and grammar are covered.	.5 credit BAL
Independent Writing	Grammar usage, creative, expository and business writing development. Available to 11 th , and 12 th grade students.	.5 credit BEL
Independent Reading	Selected novels, short stories, fiction, non-fiction. Write book reports and keep a journal. Available to 11 th and 12 th grade students.	.5 credit BEL
9th Grade World History	Ancient civilizations, Eastern Asia, Southern Asia and American history. The impact of geography, civics and economics on major historical events will be discussed.	.5 credit CEL
20th Century American History	10 th grade level. A comprehensive study of the 20 th Century and America's interaction with the world at large. The American perspective on themes and issues is examined	.5 credit CH2
Algebra 1 - PLATO	Basic algebraic methods and applications to real life situations. A scientific calculator is a necessity; graphing calculator is recommended.	.5 credit EMT
Geometry - PLATO	Develops an understanding of mathematical systems, practice, procedures and spatial visualization. A graphing calculator is recommended.	.5 credit EMT
Earth Science	Studies in astronomy, geology, oceanography, hydrology and meteorology.	.5 credit DSE
Biology	Studies in ecology, biochemistry, cells, genetics, evolution, anatomy and more.	.5 credit DSB
