Present: Stack, O'Neal, Cramer, Holt, Baker, Treutler, and Siemion. Absent: None


Also present: Superintendent Ingall and Terry Horton from the Johnson Center for Philanthropy at Grand Valley State University

The meeting agenda was approved as presented.

The meeting was facilitated by Terry Horton, consultant with the Johnson Center for Philanthropy at Grand Valley State University, with the purpose of reviewing compiled data gathered from board member self-assessments completed earlier in the year. The self-evaluation assessed their performance in seven categories including leadership, academic performance/accountability, board responsibilities, board effectiveness, data-driven decision-making, board-superintendent relations, and community engagement/advocacy. Ms. Horton shared data that reflected areas the board is most effective and areas that may need improvement. Board members will use the survey results to help set goals.
