### Welcome Back!

Excitement is building as our staff gears up for another great school year – a feeling that many may question in the wake of the largest unprecedented funding reduction for schools in Michigan history. Fortunately for our students and community, through a lot of hard work and cooperation, we have managed to keep our program structure intact and our students as the top priority. To do this, we have made adjustments in several areas to bring down costs and increase revenues. This includes applying our long standing policy of requiring students who live within a mile radius of their school to walk, and for some students, to walk a bit further to a bus stop at the outer edge of their neighborhood. You will also notice a modest increase in athletic participation fees along with a tightening up of transportation availability to and from athletic events. These are just a few examples of the many adjustments that have allowed us to avoid significant layoffs or program reductions. Your understanding and support has been, and will continue to be, tremendously appreciated.

Most importantly, your children will be coming back to a full continuum of service that includes seven buildings that have now been updated through our community's bond support for new energy upgrades (i.e. windows, doors, boilers, lighting, carpet and ceiling tile), as well as new technology including interactive whiteboards, smart carts, and expanded computer access in all buildings. Students will also benefit from advanced implementation and enhancement of a new K-5 reading program, expanded implementation of a district-wide Capturing Kids Hearts initiative, improved writing and math programs, as well as expanded focus on bullying prevention including new safe zone contacts for issues of harassment or discrimination. All are very exciting; with the underlying goal of doing all we can to very intentionally meet the needs of all of our students.

Equally exciting are the many new partnerships that are developing with neighboring districts and municipalities to keep our costs down, as well as to create new learning opportunities for our students. Examples include sharing an Operations Director position with Spring Lake Public Schools; partnering with our local Community Foundation, Chamber of Commerce and Intermediate School District to focus on improving College Access; as well as sharing resources with neighboring municipalities. These efforts will be ongoing as we continue to do all we can to keep resources in our classrooms.

Together, with our incredible staff, I want to welcome you and your children back to a new and exciting school year. We have much to be proud and anxiously await your return!

# Preschool / Child Care / Special Education Availability

## Great Start Readiness Program

The Great Start Readiness Program is a free preschool program funded by the state of Michigan. Great Start Readiness uses Creative Curriculum, a research-based early childhood curriculum that allows teachers to focus on children’s strengths and individual needs. This program is available to students who are age four by December 1, and is housed at Ferry School and Mary A. White School. There are 16 students per class, one morning and one afternoon session, and has one teacher and one assistant per class. Great Start Readiness teachers are certified with degrees in Early Childhood Education. Program enrollment is based on family income as well as other criteria. **For more information contact 616.850.5142.**

## Early Childhood Special Education

The Early Childhood Special Education (ECSE) Program emphasizes working with students with disabilities to help them become prepared for kindergarten and the rest of their school career based on their individual needs. There is an emphasis on speech and language, socialization, and working toward appropriate academic skills using scientifically-based curriculum and interventions. A speech pathologist, physical therapist, occupational therapist, psychologist, and social worker are also on staff. The average age student involved is three through five-years-old. There are 12 students per classroom, one teacher, and up to two assistants per section. ECSE is housed at Mary A. White School. **For more information contact 616.850.5142.**

## Eligibility for special education services

*Upon request, Grand Haven Area Public Schools is required to evaluate a child for eligibility for special education services. A request for evaluation is known as a referral. When the district receives a referral, the district will appoint an Individualized Education Program (IEP) team to determine if the child has a disability and if the child needs special education services. The district locates, identifies, and evaluates all children with disabilities who are enrolled by their parents in private (including religious) schools, elementary schools and secondary schools located in the school district.*

*A physician, nurse, psychologist, social worker, or administrator of a social agency who reasonably believes a child brought to him or her for services is a child with a disability has a legal duty to refer the child, including a homeless child, to the school district in which the child resides. Before referring the child, the person making the referral must inform the child’s parent that the referral will be made.*

*Others, including parents, who reasonably believe a child is a child with a disability may also refer the child, including a homeless child, to the school district in which the child resides.*

*Referrals must be in writing and include the reason why the person believes the child is a child with a disability. A referral may be made by contacting Kate Augustyn, Director of Special Education, Grand Haven Area Public Schools, at (616) 850-5142, or by writing a FERPA notification at 1415 Beechtree, Grand Haven, Michigan 49417.*

## Prime-Time

Prime-Time is an extension of the Open Door childcare program, and is developed for children three-years-of-age through kindergarten, with the exception of the Central School site who take two-and-a-half-year-olds who are not yet potty trained. Early childhood teachers work with the children daily to help them prepare and flow into a school routine. Children of this young age need structure and encouragement. Staff provides this continuity along with meeting each child’s needs on an individual basis. Children learn and socialize with other children to create a positive feeling about school. **For more information contact 616.850.6825.**

## Head Start

The Head Start Program prepares children to be successful in kindergarten through the use of hands-on experiences and activities within the research-based Creative Curriculum program. There is an emphasis on all aspects of development (social-emotional, physical, cognitive, and fine motor skills) as well as the individual’s strengths and needs. Head Start is available to three and four-year-olds, and is housed at Ferry School. There is a food service person and Family Services Advocate. There are 17 children per class, two classes with one teacher and one assistant per class. Program enrollment is based on family income as well as other criteria. **Please call 616.850.5142 for more information.**

## Developmental Preschool

The Developmental Preschool Program is a tuition-based program available to students ages two to five-years-old. This program is attuned to current trends in early childhood education and provides developmentally appropriate learning that is connected to the K-12 curriculum. The goal is to prepare children through the creative use of activity centers for successful entry into kindergarten. There are 18 students per class, one teacher and one assistant per class. Developmental Preschool is available at Central, Griffin, Lake Hills, and Robinson schools. Scholarships are available based on income. **For more information contact 616.850.6825.**

## Open Door Childcare Program

Open Door is a licensed childcare program designed to meet the needs of all children. We are conveniently located within most elementary schools for before and after school care. Prime-Time is an extension of our Open Door program developed for children three-years-old through kindergarten with the exception of Central, which takes two and-a-half-year-olds who are not yet potty-trained. Our caring staff strives to build self-esteem, creativity, and a fun filled atmosphere for children of all ages. Open Door is also available on snow, fog, in-service, half and vacation days!

### Affordable.

Open Door offers half hour, hourly, daily, and weekly rates and multiple child discounts. We also accept payment by cash, check, debit, or credit card (Mastercard and Visa).

### Flexible.

Schedule your child only for the hours you need care. All we ask is that your schedule be turned in by the Wednesday prior to needing care, along with payment.

### Convenient.

**Before** (6:30-8:30 a.m.) and **after-school** (4:00-6:00 p.m.) care available and at Ferry, Griffin, Lake Hills, Peach Plains, Robinson, and Rosy Mound elementary schools.

**Prime-Time** (full-day care) available 6:30 a.m.-6:00 p.m. at Central, Griffin, Lake Hills, and Robinson.

## School Closing Procedures

The safety of all children in the district is always a primary concern. The administration has consulted with emergency and police agencies in the development of these procedures to guard the safety and comfort of every child. It is important that parents know the district emergency school closing procedures, which are uniform in elementary, middle and high schools.

## Delayed Opening

In some cases, such as fog or slippery roads, a temporary hazardous condition may exist and allow school to be in session after a "brief" waiting period in the morning.

## Emergency Closing Before Starting Time (snow, ice, fog)

The decision to close schools because of weather is made in cooperation with state, county and local authorities. The decision is normally made prior to 5:30 a.m. However, in case of rapidly changing weather conditions, the decision could be made later.

## Early Dismissal After School is in Session

When inclement weather begins to build up during the school day, the administration may dismiss school early. When school is cancelled, local radio stations will be notified. Buses will start their runs early so that special education and elementary students can be delivered home as soon as possible. Parents are encouraged to make advanced plans for the care of students in this circumstance.

## Mechanical Failure

If it is determined that a mechanical failure cannot be repaired within an appropriate time, classes will be cancelled for the remainder of the day. Students will be returned home after morning transportation runs have been completed or as early as it is feasible to obtain bus transportation. It is imperative that parents discuss the possibility of early dismissal thoroughly with their children and make certain they know where to go if parents are not at home.

## After-school Activities

Activities scheduled after the end of the school day will be cancelled if the safety and well-being of students and staff are jeopardized. The responsible administrator(s), in consultation with other appropriate officials (e.g. National Weather Service officials, Civil Defense officials, appropriate law enforcement agencies, etc.), will determine whether conditions require the cancellation of such activities.

## Tornado Conditions

While a tornado is not a frequent occurrence, each school conducts tornado drills routinely so that all children are familiar with the procedure. Each building is in direct radio communication with the National Weather Service and is provided advance notice of tornado conditions.

## Tornado Watch

In the event of a tornado watch (conditions capable of producing a tornado), we are notified immediately by law enforcement authorities and are provided continuous up-to-the-minute reports on condition changes in our area. Parents are asked not to telephone the school during such time, as it is imperative that telephone lines be kept open to relay emergency instructions from authorities. Should a tornado watch be in effect at school dismissal time, students will be released to go home in the normal manner. There may be times when athletic, co-curricular, and recreational programs will be canceled if the watch is still in effect.

## Tornado Warning

Students will not be sent home if a tornado is sighted in the area. Immediate safety measures will be taken; students will remain at emergency stations until the district is notified that the danger is past. Parents are urged to leave their children in the safety of the school building when a tornado warning (sighting) is in effect. We agree with Civil Defense authorities that children are safer in school than they would be traveling home from school. If you must pick up your child, do not telephone; go to the school office and arrange to have your child released to you. Do not ask an older child or neighbor to pick up your child, as school authorities will release a child only to parents. Your cooperation is appreciated in helping to ensure the safety of your youngsters during emergency situations. Your observance of these procedures will enable us to achieve our common goal of safety for every student.

Grand Haven Area Public Schools has conducted an extensive asbestos survey of all its buildings. Based on the findings of this inspection, a comprehensive management plan has been drafted. This plan details the response actions that the district will be taking regarding asbestos-containing materials found in its buildings.

This plan is available for inspection at the Education Service Center (1415 Beechtree) during normal business hours. If you desire to have a personal copy, please notify Ted Rescorla, Director of Operations, and a copy will be supplied to you at a cost of \$1 per page within five working days.

We have endeavored to make our schools a safe place in which students can learn. Our procedures for dealing with this problem reflect that concern. If you have any questions, please contact 850.5120.



## Pesticide application pre-notification

GHAPS has adopted an integrated pest management program (IPM). Inherent with this are the district's efforts to reduce pesticide use as much as possible. While it may occasionally be necessary to apply a pesticide, it will only be used as a last resort.

You have the right to be informed prior to any pesticide application that might be needed in your child's school. In an emergency, pesticides will be applied without prior notice, but you will be provided notice following any such application. To receive notification, please complete the following information. If the form is not returned we will assume you do not want to be notified. Should you have questions or concerns at any time, please contact Ted Rescorla at 850.5120.

## Transportation

The staff of the Transportation Department is committed to safely transporting students to and from school and school-sponsored events. In providing this service, we are bound by set guidelines provided by the board of education. These guidelines define the level and limit of service that can be provided in keeping with cost-effective operation and services required to meet the educational needs of the school district's students.

*Some of these operational guidelines will impact you directly and, therefore, are pointed out below:*

- Students residing within one (1) mile of their schools are not eligible for transportation.
- A bus stop for a student eligible for transportation can be up to, but no further than, one (1) mile from his/her residence.
- Buses are to operate at maximum seat usage, but within the rated capacity of the bus by type.
- A student's riding time should not exceed one (1) hour.
- Transportation will not be provided for social activities (i.e. parties, social functions, go home with a friend, etc.)
- You must be at your bus stop five minutes prior to your scheduled pick-up time. Buses do not follow an exact time schedule due to varying traffic, weather and road conditions.
- Students suspended from school lose riding privileges for the duration of the suspension.
- School district transportation will not be used to transport students to or from work. With permission from parents and school administrators, students may get off their assigned buses at existing stops for the purpose of work.
- Items taken on the bus must be enclosed in a standard-sized tote bag or backpack. If your project or item that you need to get to school is too large for the backpack, you need to make arrangements to get to school or have the item dropped off at school for you.

When a disciplinary problem occurs, the driver will fill out a "Report of Misconduct on School Vehicles" form. Two copies go home to the parent, one copy to the Transportation Director, and one copy goes to the school principal.

A set number of points are assessed for each rule violation and serve to determine the duration of suspension from bus riding privileges. When the period of suspension has been served, the student must return the pink copy of the form signed by a parent before he/ she may resume riding the bus. Points are cumulative. Once 20 points have been accumulated, bus-riding privileges are suspended for the remainder of the year.

**Remember, bus transportation is a privilege. There is no requirement of law, which mandates it be provided to you.** It is a service we gladly provide to enhance the convenience of education for students and parents. What we ask in return is that students simply conduct themselves in a manner which is in keeping with the safety and due respect of others.



## Transportation

**Transfer policy:** Transportation for school-of-choice transfer students within and from outside the school district is provided on a space-available basis. A “School of Choice Request for Bus Transportation” form has been submitted. This form is available at any Grand Haven Area Public Schools building.

1. Pick-up and take-home bus stops must be at existing stops along an existing route, which services the school-of-choice area.
2. The bus stop requested must be within one mile safe walking distance from the student’s home or day care location.

**No transfer situations:** i.e. student living in Lakeshore Middle School area going to White Pines Middle School as a school-of-choice requests a bus in his/her area take him/her to the high school for a transfer to a second bus going to White Pines Middle School.

### *Students must:*

1. Be at assigned bus stop on time.
2. Not litter on the school bus.
3. Stay off the roadway: maintain proper conduct while waiting for or leaving a school bus.
4. Get on and off at the designated stop. Changes must be approved in writing by a school authority.
5. Not talk in a loud voice or shout or create any other disturbing noises.
6. Remain seated. The driver is authorized to assign seats.
7. Not eat or drink on the school bus without permission of the bus driver or teacher or chaperone.
8. Not use profane or vulgar language, or make obscene gestures.
9. Cross in front of the bus, not in back.
10. Keep head and hands inside the bus.
11. Not throw objects on the bus or out of the window of the bus.
12. Obey instructions of and show respect to the driver.
13. Not harass or bully others, or otherwise be unruly.
14. Not fight.
15. Not spit or bite.
16. Not damage or vandalize the school bus. Students will be required to pay for repair of damage.
17. Not possess or use flammable or explosive devices on the bus.
18. Not possess or use illegal / dangerous substances/items on the bus.
19. Not possess or use tobacco products on the bus.
