

**GRAND HAVEN HIGH SCHOOL
ATHLETIC AND CO-CURRICULAR
TRANSPORTATION PROCEDURE AND PERMISSION SLIP**

It is the policy of the Grand Haven Area Public Schools to provide safe, economical transportation to the students of the District. Occasionally, when students participate in athletics or other District-sponsored co-curricular activities, students or their parents/guardians prefer to transport the students to or from an event in a private vehicle. District policy allows for student transportation in private vehicles subject to the rules and regulations established by the administration, and provided the student's parent/guardian has requested permission for such transportation. This document serves as the general rules and regulations, as well as the permission slip, for allowing student transportation in private vehicles. The District will allow a student whose parent/guardian completes this form to ride to or from District-sponsored athletic and co-curricular events under the following conditions.

- Students are not permitted to drive themselves or other students to or from an event.

- Coaches and advisors are responsible for ensuring that all students are either riding home with their own parent/guardian or with another student's parent/guardian.

- A completed permission slip signed by the parent/guardian of a student to be transported is required before the student may ride to or from an event with another student's parent/guardian. This permission slip must be kept on file by the coach/advisor, and a copy shall be given to the Athletic/Main Office.

- **Parents/guardians who transport other students to or from events are required to submit a copy of their driver's license and auto insurance AND have a completed Volunteer Assessment Form on file with the Athletic Office.**

By marking this box on the Athletic Check-List form, you are granting permission to allow your student to ride to or from District sponsored athletic events and co-curricular activities in a private vehicle subject to the above rules and regulations.
