# 2015-2016 REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION

Credit is granted for each semester of successfully completed course work. A diploma will not be issued to a student who has not been in attendance at Grand Haven High School for at least one semester of their senior year or earned less than two credits, including one credit of math. The high school, working closely with each student and his/her parent or guardian, will plan a program appropriate to the student's educational needs and interests. Students who have completed all requirements for graduation from Grand Haven Area Public Schools may be issued a diploma. Students shall have been in attendance in grades 9-12 for eight (8) semesters, or the equivalent, by the time of graduation. During each of the eight (8) semesters, students will be enrolled in a minimum of six (6) classes. Those students wishing to graduate early must have approval from the principal. Students interested in this option need to see their counselor.

Foreign Exchange students will be issued a diploma upon completion of the same basic requirements expected of other regularly enrolled Grand Haven High School students (Policy #5118.1). In order to qualify for a Grand Haven High School diploma, an exchange student must attend at least one school year and be in their senior year of high school.
