The Board of Education met on Monday, June 10, 2024, at 7:00 pm at Grand Haven High School.

- We had two great graduation ceremonies a couple weeks ago. Congratulations to both of our high schools for organizing these outstanding events. The weather was beautiful for both and the students were amazing.
   Congratulations to all of our graduates.
- Our spring sports season has been very successful of late as our teams and individuals have turned in outstanding performances.
  - Our boys club volleyball team finished as state runner ups for the 2nd year in a row.
  - Boys track and field earned a 6th place finish this past weekend in the division 1 state meet. Seth Norder was the state champion in the 1600 meter run. (His 3rd state title).
  - Girls soccer won both the district and regional championships.
  - Boys baseball were district champions.
  - Girls tennis qualified for the state tournament for the first time in many years.

- We are still waiting to hear more from the state regarding a school aide budget. We are hoping it comes soon.
   Without this information, it is very difficult to develop our budget, but be aware we are being conservative in our planning.
- We sent out information regarding the sinking fund on Wednesday, June 5th. It included information on our website.
- We have a number of special guests here this evening from the High School Science Olympiad team. This
  incredible program has won 31 Regional championships, 19 state championships and 3 national
  championships in their 38 years of competition. Scott introduced Science Olympiad Head Coach Mike Reed.

Mike Reed introduced the thirteen (13) of the nineteen (19) students who competed this year. Many of these students have participated in Science Olympiad since 6th grade. Their dedication, passion and endless hours are admirable. Mike shared his extreme appreciation for the team of coaches that share their expertise, time and passion for Science Olympiad, our long-standing successes would not be possible without our coaches. Student Kari Taylor recognized Coach Mike Reed and all his hard work.
