Course Description

This course will continue beyond the introduction of the world of design and media, including web design, graphic design concepts, video production, audio editing, drone operation, photography, and storyboarding covered in Digital Design I.. Students will use Adobe Creative Cloud (CC) products. Students will use this software suite to create real-world projects such as professional websites, logos, commercials, and their own YouTube channel featuring a variety of vlogs on topics of interest. Equipment used will include GoPro 5, DSLR cameras, drones, gimbals, external microphones and more! Student projects will include partnerships with local businesses and GHAPS. There will be heavy emphasis on working on real-world projects with local companies, coaches, and advisors.
