Course Description

Accounting is basically the financial language of business operation. Students will learn the complete accounting cycle, from analyzing transactions, to creating a post-closing trial balance, payroll, and the use of special journals. We use on-line working papers to simulate real-world activities.

Students will walk away from this course with a working knowledge of how businesses manage their finances, both on paper and using accounting software.
