Course Description

In Earth Science, students will study the world around us, the processes that help shape it, and its place in the universe. Learning will take place through hands-on activities, discussions, presentations, projects, and other classroom events.

Course Objectives

Students will develop an understanding of how the world functions and an appreciation for the delicate balance of Earth. Units of study will include, astronomy, evolution of earth, plate tectonics, Earth history, motion of water, phases of water, freshwater, oceanography, weather and climate, and human impact.
