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Deutsch 2 - Semester 1 - Syllabus

In German 2, you will continue your language learning journey. As you have experienced, language learning doesn't happen overnight. To be sure, it will take dedication and practice on your part. We will continue to learn about life and culture in Germany and through German speaking people in the world while working towards fluency. We'll wrap up learning in the Komm Mit! Level 1 textbook and move to Komm Mit! Level 2. I hope that this year you will build confidence, enjoy learning about other cultures and experience new things along the way. Curriculum by unit themes:

Amerikaner in München (traveling to Munich) In this unit, students will learn their way around an unfamiliar city. Students will learn about important places in a city and how to ask for and understand directions to navigate from one place to the next.

Kino und Konzerte (movies and concerts) In this unit, students will learn to discuss likes and preferences in the context of popular media like movies and music.

Der Geburtstag (the birthday) In this unit, students will learn complex grammar as they discuss holidays, birthdays and gift giving habits.

Bastis Plan (Sebastian's Plan) In this unit, students will review German I and German II grammar and vocabulary while Basti's plan to get out of doing chores plays out. So ein Schlitzohr!

Pacing:

I'll teach and you'll learn four units this semester. At the end of each unit you'll be assessed over all of the content for that unit. Expect smaller assessments along the way so I can keep my eyes on learning and come back around to anything we've missed before the end of the unit. Language learning takes practice in *reading*, *writing*, *listening* and *speaking*. You will practice all of those on the days we are together when possible.

Assessments will include all of those areas, too. We'll have 8 to 9 class periods, 90 minutes each, to complete each unit.
