# **Course Description**

Jewelry 1, an advanced art course, is for students who have an interest in creating original jewelry. Students will utilize advanced construction techniques and develop their own. Students will apply these techniques in modern ways to make aesthetically pleasing and functional pieces. Original, well-planned projects with quality craftsmanship and aesthetic considerations are required.

# **Course Objectives**

- To foster creative thought and expression through jewelry construction
- To use the elements of art and the principles of design in original jewelry design/creation
- To become familiar with and use vocabulary specific to jewelry making
- To understand and appreciate the value of jewelry making
- To become familiar with, as well as, to appreciate the historical aspects of jewelry making through the exploration of techniques and varied artists
- To understand and appreciate the value of critique
- To heighten perceptual awareness
- To understand form and function as it applies to art
- To create functional and aesthetically pleasing jewelry products with high quality craftsmanship
- To gain mastery in various jewelry materials, tools and techniques
- To identify stages of completion required in jewelry design/creation
- To evaluate design/creation in jewelry making

Students are expected to follow the rules of the studio, including etiquette and clean up. Participation, on-task use of class time and project progression will be assessed with studio grades.

Students will be sharing a tool kit with one or more student(s). Students are responsible for the proper use/care of assigned supplies/equipment. In the event that materials may need to be taken home, students will check them out and be responsible for returning them in good condition or will be charged a replacement value.

# **Grading Policy**

#### **CLASS REQUIREMENTS:**

There is a \$40.00 fee to take this class. Please make checks payable to Grand Haven High School. Payment is expected by the end of the first full week of class.

1. **PORTFOLIO:** (70%) A portfolio is the collection of art products created during class. These works will receive grades consisting of but not limited to:

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- a. Creativity: Your ideas, process and originality
- b. **Planning and Vocabulary/Art History:** Portfolio work will require pre-planning and notes to be turned in by their due dates.
- c. Level of Mastery: Did you understand and follow directions?
- d. **Technique/Craftsmanship:** How well is the work done?
- e. **Portfolio Documentation:** Students will be responsible for completing each assignment and turning it in along with a self-reflection sheet.
- f. **Critique:** Students will be required to participate in class discussions and peer critiques.
- 2. STUDIO WORK ASSIGNMENTS: (30%) Short term assignments, research, note taking, quizzes and critiques completed in and outside of class. Sketches and/or preliminary exercises will be required before the completion of each assignment. Students will also receive a daily grade worth 10 points toward the progress, process and work completed during class.

**FINAL EXAM:** A final exam will be given that will include a written test and the average of the portfolio grades throughout the semester.

**SEMESTER GRADE**: The semester grade will be an average of the term grade (80%) and the final exam (20%).

WHILE ARTISTS WORK AT VARIED PACES, YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO COMPLETE ALL PROJECTS THAT ARE ASSIGNED AND MAY NEED TO REQUEST TIME IN ACADEMY.
