What Mason Tenders do?

- Cut materials to specified sizes for installation, using power saws.
- Stocks material, Supplies Bricklayer
- Erect scaffolding or other installation structures.
- Prepare mortar and grout.
- General clean-up of debris.
- Arrange or store materials, tools, or equipment.
- Remove damaged brick or mortar, and clean or prepare surfaces, using hammers, chisels, drills.
- Locate and prepare materials for masons to install, possibly following drawings or numbered sequences.
- Clean block walls, prepare for paint.
- Move or position materials such as stone slabs, steel elements using cranes, hoists, or dollies.

What work activities are most important?

- Handling and Moving Objects Using hands and arms in handling, installing, positioning, and moving materials, and manipulating things.
- Getting Information Observing, receiving, and otherwise obtaining information from all relevant sources.
- Making Decisions and Solving Problems Analyzing information and evaluating results to choose the best solution and solve problems.
- Performing General Physical Activities Performing physical activities that require considerable use of your arms and legs and moving your whole body, such as climbing, lifting, balancing, walking, stooping, and handling of materials
- Identifying Objects, Actions, and Events Identifying information by categorizing, estimating, recognizing differences or similarities, and detecting changes in circumstances or events.
- Monitor Processes, Materials, or Surroundings Monitoring and reviewing information from materials, events, or the environment, to detect or assess problems.
- Operating Vehicles, Mechanized Devices, or Equipment Running, maneuvering, navigating, or driving vehicles or mechanized equipment, such as forklifts.
- Controlling Machines and Processes Using either control mechanisms or direct physical activity to operate machines or processes.
- Communicating with Supervisors, Peers, or Subordinates Providing and receiving information to supervisors, coworkers, and subordinates.
- Organizing, Planning, and Prioritizing Work Developing specific goals and plans to prioritize, organize, and accomplish your work.
